We have gained a lot of interest from the government so far and have received visits from John Summers the Director of Equalities and Professor Angela O Hagen and her team from The Scottish Human Rights Commission. We have raised many questions with the visitors about the human rights of the Castlemilk community, mainly the lack of a supermarket or local health centre and now hope to send a submission to Geneva for their meeting in February.

The group consists of board members from the four community based housing associations and we have a brilliant Human Rights consultant Carole Ewart who produced a brilliant booklet about human rights.

We are serviced by Ardenglen Housing Association and I'm hoping by sending this information to the EVH membership that others may be interested. We would be happy to come and talk to some housing associations about setting up a network as this would give us a bigger voice in our fight for our human rights.
