Almond Housing Association have unveiled their new property in Rowan Terrace, Blackburn, which was built with grant funding from the Scottish Government. The new development contains 20 one and two bedroomed flats for general housing needs, by the first weekend, 19 of the 20 flats were occupied.

Housing Manager Jonathan Bertram said: "The team worked really hard to ensure that the properties could be occupied as quickly as possible, with Linsey allocating the flats and Will completing the viewings and sign-ups. It is a fabulous development and all tenants seem really happy with their new homes, which for some is their first home."

In line with statutory requirements, just over 50% of the properties let to those who were homeless or at risk of being homeless. Also housed were two graduates from the Rock Trust Live and Work project, which supports young people to live independently and engage in education, employment or training.
