Civic reception for Elderpark Housing Association to

mark 50 years!



Elderpark Housing was honoured by Glasgow City Council with a civic reception on August 8 and took place at the City Chambers as Elderpark continues to celebrate its 50th anniversary. The occasion allowed many people who have contributed to the organisation over the last five decades to mark this important milestone.
