Neuro-difference and the Workplace

Speaker: Dr Munna Roy – Thursday 29 October

There has been an increase in diagnosis of neuro-different conditions over the last decade. ACAS estimates 15–20% of UK adults are neurodivergent with the main classifications being Dyslexia, ADHD, Autism and Developmental Co-ordination Disorder (dyspraxia). There can often be management and workplace performance challenges due to these neuro-differences and in many such workers, the protections of the Equality Act 2010 will apply. Employers often lack confidence in managing these workplace situations. This session will give an overview of neurodivergent classifications and provide guidance on how to harness individual strengths so organisations can benefit from neuro-difference in the workplace.
