Additional Funding Secured for Medical Adaptations

Knowes Housing Association are pleased to share they have received additional grant funding from the Scottish Government to support essential medical adaptations, helping tenants remain safely and comfortably in their homes.

Due to the high level of adaptation requests Knowes receive each year, their annual grant is often not sufficient to meet all needs immediately. For 2025–26, their initial allocation was £25,000. As in previous years, they highlighted that this funding would not cover all outstanding requests.

This year, they were awarded an additional £45,000 enabling them to carry out adaptations in five more homes. These improvements are already having a life changing impact on tenants.

One tenant, who received a ramp installation through the additional funding, shared the difference it has made for them:

“Having a ramp installed has completely changed my life. When I came out of hospital, I was housebound, but the ramp has given me my independence back and I’m absolutely over the moon with it. I never expected it to be fitted so quickly, it has been amazing. I’m now able to get out and about again.”
