- Further to earlier updates regarding the pay negotiations EVH attended and participated in conciliation through ACAS. Further to this EVH welcomed more constructive dialogue with UNITE which resulted in both parties approaching ongoing discussions with a view to looking at practical solutions. These subsequent discussions led to an agreement which both parties agreed to recommend to their respective memberships. The ballots are ongoing with confirmation of the results expected by the afternoon of Thursday 28th March when the employer's ballot has closed.
- Several **legislative changes** are coming into force in April this year. The full member terms and conditions of employment have been reviewed, updated, and circulated to members. All changes have been discussed and agreed through the JNC.
